Thomas John works as Principal Legal Officer at the Permanent Bureau of the Hague Conference of Private International Law. He will discuss identification of typical risks in cross-border transactions with a particular focus on certain transactional, litigation and enforcement risks typically encountered by parties. While domestic settings are used for comparison purposes, Thomas will concentrate on the international aspects of those risks, introducing risk management and mitigation strategies,

including as available under the 2005 Hague Choice of Court Convention which has entered into force for Austria (1-X-2015) and all other Member States, including the United Kingdom, of the European Union as well as non EU trading partners such as Singapur, Mexiko and Montenegro. China has signed the Convention in December 2017.
